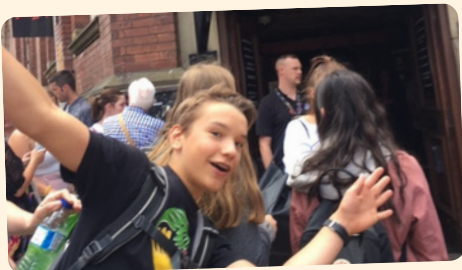

FAQs

How do I register?

You can sign up via our website - <https://education-together.org/#locals>. This will take you to an information page and payment link. Following registration we will send you more details and a link to our personal information form, also accessible [here](#). This needs to be done with a parent or guardian as it is important we have their permission for you to participate.



Are places limited?

Yes, we have a limited number of places. That means we will confirm participation on a first come, first served basis. Thanks for understanding. If you miss out this time we will give you priority booking for future opportunities.

If I sign-up, will I be with my friends?

We understand that for most of us it is reassuring (and fun) to be with friends. The programme is also a chance to meet new people which has benefits too. Our aim is to help you find the right balance. When you sign-up, please tell us if you have friends who are registering. We will then make sure you are in groups with people you know.

Do I need to sign-up for all six days?

The programme is designed for people who want to come for the full week and works out slightly cheaper if you do. However, we understand this may not be possible for everyone. You can tell us which days you can make on our signup form. We will try to accommodate everyone although places are limited. Individual days cost £10 per day or £45 for all 6 days

Do I need to bring food?

Everyone will need to bring their own packed lunch to eat during the day. We have a **NO NUT POLICY** in place for the summer due to the specific needs of some participants. Don't forget to bring a water bottle and dress for the weather. You will also need trainers or other shoes for walking about in.

I have additional needs, can I still participate?

Our aim is to make our programmes as inclusive and accessible as possible. We will work with you and your parents to make any reasonable adjustments necessary for you to participate. We will need to discuss and agree plans in advance and if required, agree how to arrange additional support with your family's help. Our number one priority will be to make sure everything can be done safely. If you want to discuss this further, don't hesitate to get in touch.
